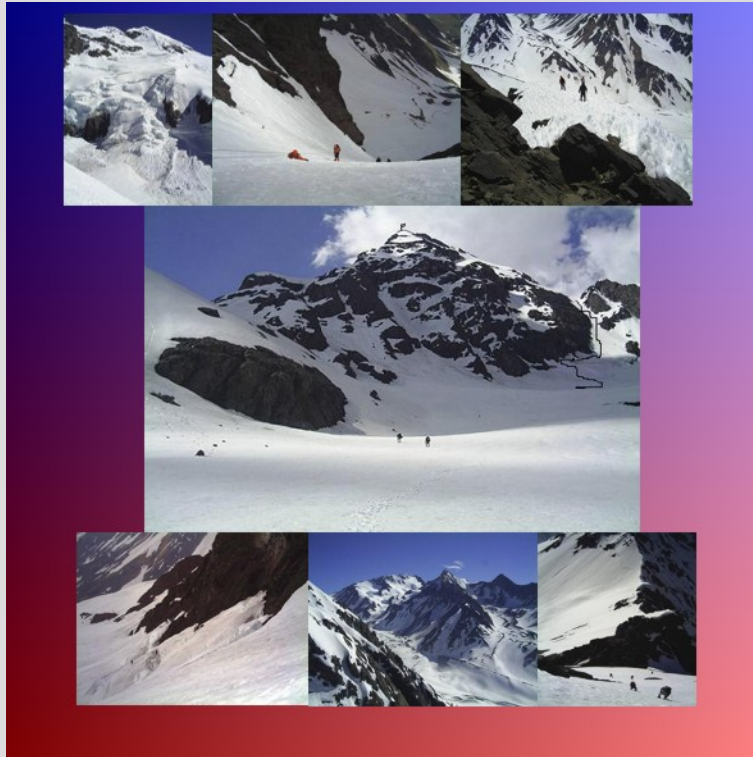


**MIRADOR DEL MORADO - 3.883 meters - CLIMB ITINERARY**



<b>DAY 1:</b>	Group meets in Santiago. Equipment check. For dinner we will have a chance to taste fine Chilean cuisine and wine.
<b>DAY 2:</b>	Drive east from Santiago towards to Canyon del Maipo. We stop at "Baños Morales National Park" where we will start walking. Porters will carry most of our gear. After a full day following "Quebrada de Morales" Valley we arrive to our base camp on a "High Plateau" at 2.462 meters.
<b>DAY 3:</b>	Summit day! After reaching the summit the descent will be by the same route. Several options are possible depending on the route we choose. Most likely we will climb a steep glacier on "Canaleta", challenging snow and ice route. (45° to 65° hard Snow/Ice).
<b>DAY 4:</b>	Descend to Baños Morales National Park entrancy, lodging in Refugio Lo Valdés.
<b>DAY 5:</b>	Several options are possible depending on the preferences we choose or come back to Santiago to your place. Rock Climbing / Rafting / Hiking / Thermal Baths / etc. (Extra fee)

**This itinerary is intended to be a guideline only, weather days and rest days are always a possibility while on a climbing trip.**

**COST INCLUDES**

Mountain Guides, one dinner in Santiago, all land transportation, mules, all food while in the mountains, all community gear (tents, stoves, cooking gear, ropes, ice screws, pickets, medical kit, Gps, Satellite Phone, etc.)

**YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR**

Flights to Santiago, meals in Santiago, personal equipment, passport, Insurances, personal items and services (laundry, drinks, tips, etc.), and expenses incurred in the event of a rescue.
