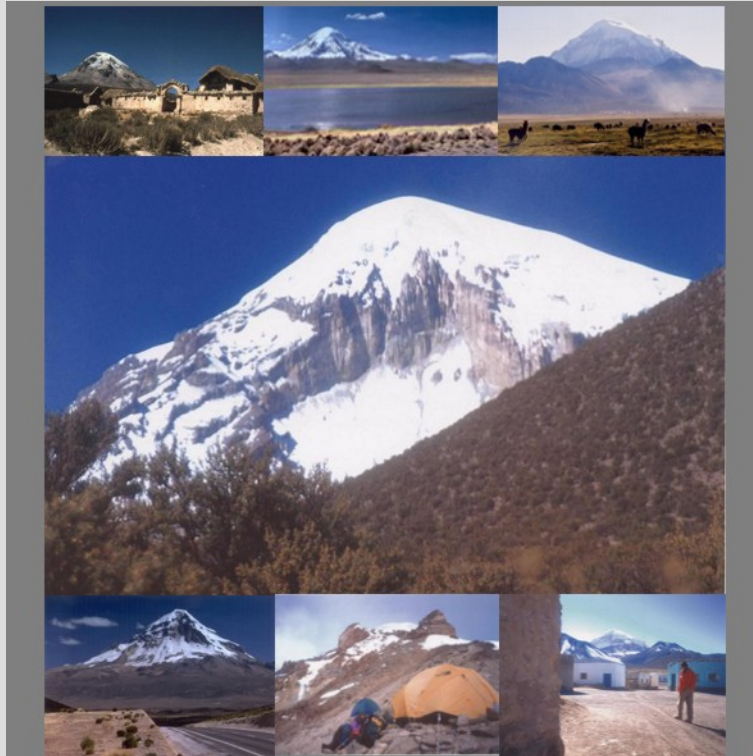


NEVADO SAJAMA - 6.542 meters - CLIMB ITINERARY
CODE: SAJAMA 07
BASE 3 PAX



DAY 1:	Group meets in Santiago Airport – Transfer and Equipment check in the Hotel 4 stars. For dinner we will have a chance to taste fine Chilean cuisine and wine.
DAY 2:	Fly to Arica. We will take our transport toward to Putre at 3.500 meters.
DAY 3:	Acclimatization period in Putre.
DAY 4:	Hike in the morning toward to Nevados de Putre at 5.775 meters but not to the top, will be acclimatization period (“Nevados de Taapacá and Ancoma”).
DAY 5:	Drive to the Village of Sajama, then towards the Wincurata Area. We will spend the night in simple aymará style or just outside the village, depends on the group.
DAY 6:	Acclimatization period in Wincurata.
DAY 7:	We will begin our 3 hour trek to Base Camp at 4.800 meters.
DAY 8:	Trek from base camp at 9:00 a.m. to the High Camp taking between 5 and 6 hours to get there at 5.700 meters.

DAY 9:	Leave High Camp at 03:00 am, (after a previous summit breakfast) reaching the summit at approximately 10:00 a.m. After resting for a few minutes at the top, we start the return journey to the High Camp, where we get things ready to return to the Base Camp immediately after. Overnigh.
DAY 10-11:	Summit! Weather permitting. We allow a window for our Summit Day in case of poor weather and depending on how group is acclimatizing.
DAY 12:	We start descending at about 09:00 a.m. back to Wincurata; from there we head to "Hot Springs" for a refreshing natural bath.
DAY 13:	Drive to Arica to Fly to Santiago OR continue climbing up to Parinacota Volcano at 6.432 meters, check SAJAMA and PARINACOTA 2007. Arrive to Pudahuel Airport around 22:30 p.m. Transfer to the Hotel.
DAY 14:	Extensión Day: Santiago City Tour / Wine Tour / Multisport Activity / Valparaiso & Viña del Mar. / Dinner. (Extra fee).
DAY 15:	Conclude our Expedition. Fly home or continue traveling in South America

This itinerary is intended to be a guideline only, weather days and rest days are always a possibility while on a climbing trip.

COST INCLUDES

Mountain Guides, All Flights in Chile, two nights hotel accommodation in Santiago (four star), Two dinner in Santiago, 3 nights accommodation in Putre, all land transportation, all food while in the mountains, all community gear (tents, stoves, cooking gear, ropes, ice screws, pickets, medical kit, Gps, Satellite Phone, etc.), mountain equipment; harness, crampons, Ice Axe, tents (for 1 people), food, kitchen utensils, mules or donkey, and porters.

YOU ARE RESPONSIBLE FOR

Meals in Santiago and Arica, personal equipment, passport, Insurances, personal items and services (laundry, drinks, tips, etc.), and expenses incurred in the event of a rescue.

COST INCLUDES

Cost per each Person US\$ 1.990 American dollars.

For Reserve Trips you must to deposit 30% of the amount at least 60 days before the Expedition.

We use donkeys or mules day 7 and 12.

Day 8 and 11 we use porters.
